

EMERGENCY WATER SHUT OFF TOMORROW!

Re: UNDERGROUND LEAK - NORTH SIDE OF ARLINGTON COMMUNITY

Hello Homeowners & Happy New Year!

Unfortunately, we have an underground leak that has sprung, and we need to investigate it ASAP! Beginning *tomorrow*, **THURSDAY**, **JANUARY 4TH**, **2024 from approximately 8:00A - 4:30P**, The City of St. Pete Water Resources, Allen's Plumbing and other licensed utility companies will be on-site on the **NORTH SIDE** only of our complex, removing pavers and digging underground!

Due to this new discovery, **WATER WILL BE SHUT OFF TOMORROW** on the **North Side only (bet. 2nd Ave. N and the alley)** to search and repair this issue. Hopefully, the repair will not go beyond one day, but <u>IF IT DOES</u>, water will be restored after 5P Thursday for the remainder of the evening, and we will post and email an update on future necessary details affecting re: water shut off, parking or repairs.

Additionally, homeowners could experience *limited or blocked* garage access and garage parking disruptions, as large trucks will be in the back area working underground and pavers will be removed, and the area taped off for safety. **We kindly ask you to park on the street during that time to avoid any parking disruptions.**

The area will be taped off and you have LIMITED access to garages while they work.
